



TRICHLOROACETIC ACID (TCA) PEEL POST TREATMENT INFORMATION

TCA Peel (25% Trichloroacetic Acid)

This TCA peel is medical strength and is only used in local areas to treat solar lentigines (brown spots) it can be used as a superficial depth peel or as a medium depth peel depending on individual needs. This peel is only available through Dermatologists or cosmetic medical clinics.

TCA Peel (15% Trichloroacetic Acid)

This TCA peel is also medical strength and is designed to treat larger areas of concern including pigmentation, discoloration and fine lines. This peel is used as a superficial depth peel.

After care for TCA 25%

- For TCA 25% spot treatment there is no preparation required
- The area will become darker and the texture will be smooth (very fine scab will form)
- It is very important to leave this scab on for as long as possible so the skin underneath can heal and there is less chance of scarring
- Apply Vaseline as required to keep moist
- The scab will fall off when its ready in about 7-10 days
- Use SPF 50+ sun protection daily

After care for Superficial 15% TCA peel whole face

In the first 24 hours

Mild redness, a tight dry feel and mild itching may occur.

3-4 days after peel

Mild itching, mild to moderate skin peeling/flaking Minor breakout may occur.

Important After Care Information

Maintain skin hydration by using gentle skincare as often as needed through the day for the first few days after your treatment. Apply SPF 50+ sunscreen daily.
